

**SUPPORTING EVIDENCE CHECKLIST
FOR DACA RENEWAL REQUESTORS**

Most DACA recipients will **not** have to send any evidence with their renewal application. There are ONLY 3 groups of people who need to send evidence with their DACA Renewal application.

If you are in any of these groups on the column on the left, talk to an immigration lawyer or a BIA accredited representative before applying for DACA renewal. They can help you figure out if it's safe to apply and what documents to send. Bring documents to the right to any consultations with a legal representative or to a DACA workshop. If you think you don't have documents on this list, that's okay – that doesn't mean you don't qualify for DACA renewal.

<p>If you have an open case in immigration court, you should bring...</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Any document issued by the immigration judge; or <input type="checkbox"/> A copy of the removal order; or <input type="checkbox"/> The final decision of the Board of Immigration Appeals</p>
<p>If you had any kind of trouble with the police since you got DACA, you should bring...</p> <p>Make sure you talk to an immigration lawyer or BIA representative before you apply for renewal.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Tickets; or <input type="checkbox"/> Citations; or <input type="checkbox"/> Court documents like judgments or indictments; or <input type="checkbox"/> Any other paperwork demonstrating what happened.</p> <p>You will need to get a copy of your criminal records. Click here for info. Find out about Post-Conviction Relief (PCR). Click here for info.</p>
<p>If you got DACA from Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)...</p> <p>How do I know if I got DACA from ICE?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check your work permit. If it expires before August 15, 2014, you got DACA from ICE. 	<p>Then you need to apply like a first time applicant.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That means you will need to send evidence showing that you meet all of the DACA requirements. • Use our Supporting Evidence Checklist for Initial Applicants.

Even if you don't have to send supporting evidence, **all renewal requestors must send:**

- **Form I-821D;**
- **Form I-765;**
- **Form I-765WS;**
- **two passport-style photographs** with your name and A-number written on the back;
- **a copy of your work permit** (front and back); and
- **a check or money order for \$465** made out to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, unless you got special permission from the government to apply for free.
